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**Notes for licences with advance fixing of the refund:**

Licence requirements

**If there is a refund in force, but you do not wish to claim this refund, then you do not require a licence, with the exception of the products listed in table 2 below.**

#### Issue dates

Licences with Advance Fixing of the refund or export tax will be issued on the third working day following the date which the application was lodged.

#### Rates of security

20 €/t for products falling within CN code 1102 20, 1103 12, 1104 1950, 1104 2310, 1108, 1702 and 2106 – if there is a refund in force, but you do not wish to claim this refund, then you do not require a licence, with the exception of the products listed below.

10 €/t for all other products

#### Validity periods

For all cereal products, licences with Advance Fixing of the refund or export tax will be valid for the remainder of the month in which the application was lodged, plus a further 4 months.

#### Special Terms of Validity for products falling within CN Code 1702 and 2106

Licences for products falling within CN codes 1702 30, 1702 40, 1702 90 and 2106 90 and where the refund has been fixed in advance, shall carry the following validity periods:

- Applications lodged up to 31 May (inclusive) will expire **30 June**
- Applications lodged 1 June – 31 August (inclusive) will expire **30 September**
- Applications lodged 1 September – 30 September (inclusive) will be **valid for 30 days**

#### Special Terms of Validity for products falling within CN Code 1107

At the request of the applicant, licences with Advance Fixing of the refund for malt products falling within CN codes 1107 1019, 1107 1099 and 1107 2000 shall carry the following validity periods:

- Applications lodged 1 January – 30 April will be valid until 30 September
- Applications lodged 1 July – 31 October (inclusive) will be valid for the month in which the application was lodged, plus a further 11 months
- Applications lodged 1 November – 31 December (inclusive) will be valid until 30 September



- set a percentage for quantities applied for

- reject all applications
- or
- suspend the lodging of applications for a maximum of 5 working days (this period may be extended at the Commission's decision)

If your application is reduced or rejected your licence security will be released immediately for the quantities not granted.

You will also be permitted to withdraw your application if the reduction results in your allocation being less than 80% of your original application. If you decide to withdraw your application, then you must do this in writing and within 3 working days of publication of the reduction.
