### **Health Certification – Meat Imports**

### **Phytosanitary Certificates**

- If you require a Phytosanitary Certificate – which refers to plant health – you should contact the DEFRA Plant Health and Seeds Inspectors contact number - 01904 455 174

### **Imports of Fish or Fish products**

- While licences are not required for imports of fish or fish products, only certain species from specified countries are allowed to enter the UK.

The imports must arrive at designated ports / airports and pass a health certification inspection.

You should refer to the Food Standards Agency – Imports Department who can advise on the points of entry, acceptable species and countries of origin.
